To whom it may concern:

Predator Drilling has had a working relationship with MEG Energy since the winter of 2010 when we utilized three of their drilling rigs at our Christina Lake core hole project. During that winter I was personally responsible for the coring program where Predator was drilling 350-500m core holes with results that surpassed my own expectations in terms of efficiency and safety. Since that project in 2010 MEG has continued to utilize Predator rigs in their core hole program and today is considered a preferred supplier of coring capable rigs.


In the summer of 2011 a new challenge was presented to Predator Drilling; to provide a rig to pre-set surface casing for our current SAGD operation. Surface casing on these wells are 13½" and 16" with an approximate depth of 135m.

Predator has demonstrated their versatility and professionalism in taking on this challenge and has delivered with professional crews and highly organized and efficient operations that have met and exceeded my expectations for the project. The results speak for themselves as Predator 3 was able to consistently set 13½" surface casing in an average of 1.0 days and set 16" surface casing in 1.25 days.

With that addition of the Predator rig we were able to get ahead of schedule and achieve our drilling targets. With pre-setting this SAGD project we were able to save not only money on a per well basis, but additional time that allows our drilling rig to stay on schedule and ahead of budget.

I would not hesitate in recommending Predator Drilling for any drilling operation, as they have demonstrated a consistent ability to perform for MEG over the past few years. I look forward to continuing business with the Predator Drilling team in the years to come.
